

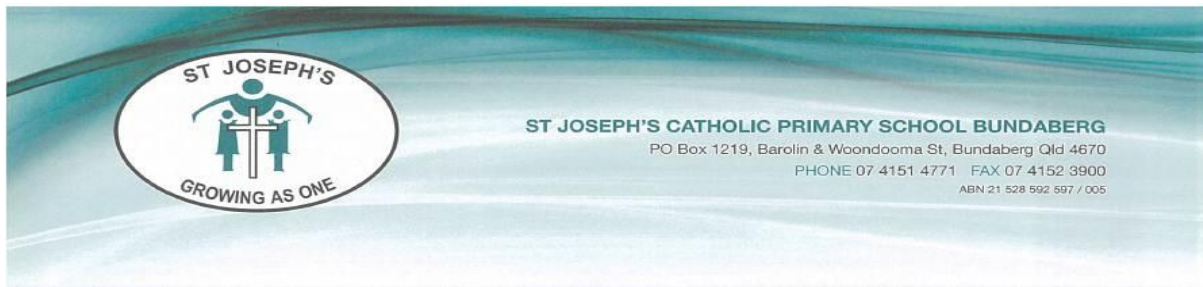

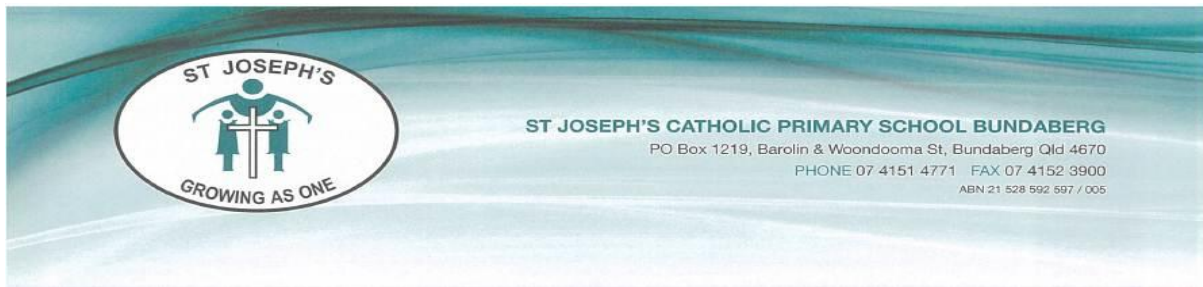

#### **PLEASE NOTE –**

You will also be required to pay their standard embroidery charge.

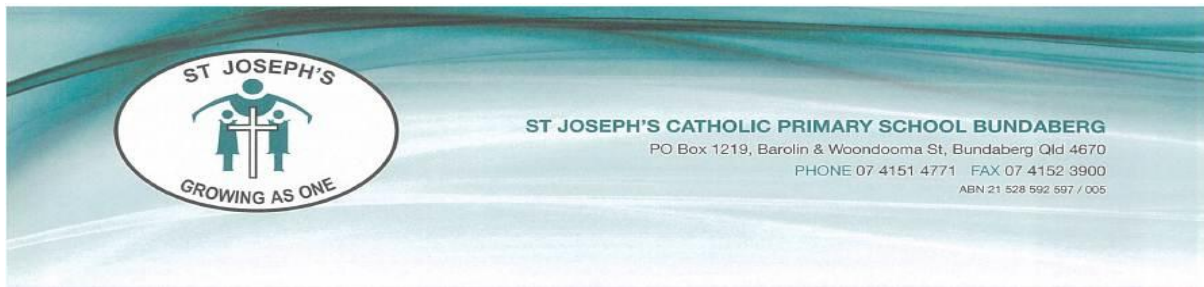


## Girls Formal Uniform

The formal uniform is worn 3 times a week –  
Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays.

- Check dress with black & white trims, oval school logo badge and button-on black tie.
- It is suggested plain black sports underwear be worn under the girls formal dress (eg. netball style underwear).
- Black opaque stockings can be worn in winter. Children should have white fold over socks for wearing if stockings are removed.
- NO tracksuit pants, leggings or skivvies under the girls formal dress.





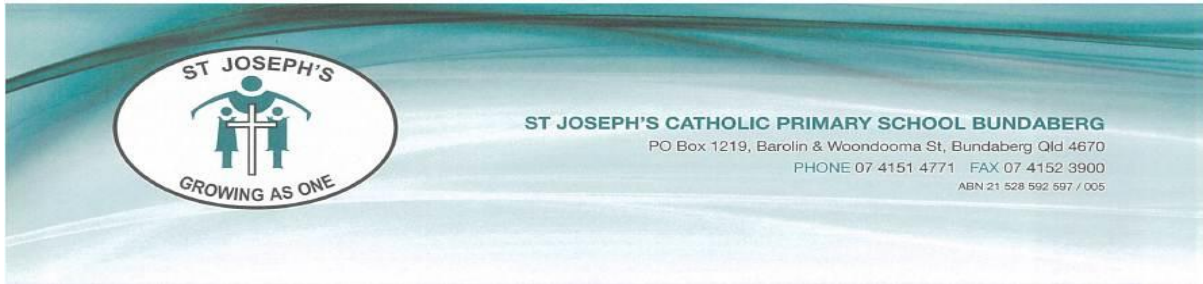
## Boys Formal Uniform

The formal uniform is worn 3 times a week on

Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays.

- Check shirt with black trim on collar and oval school logo badge on pocket.
- Black Scags drill rigger style shorts with school logo embroidered on bottom left in white.
- NO cargo pockets or basketball shorts.
- NO skivvies under the boys formal shirt.



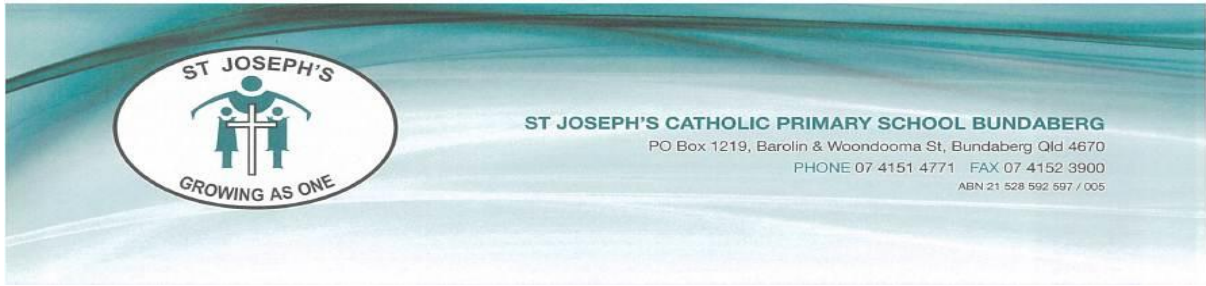


## Sport Uniform

Unisex sport uniform, for boys and girls.  
The sport uniform is worn on Monday and Friday.

- Teal St Joseph's polo shirt with black & white trim and embroidered oval school logo.
- Unisex Stubbies microfibre black sport shorts, mid length with school logo embroidered on bottom left in white.
- NO cargo pockets or basketball shorts.

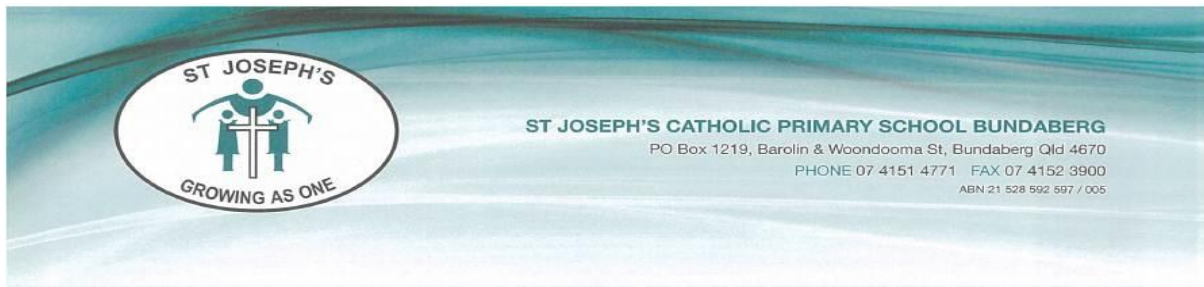




## *Sports Uniform Cont.*

- Girls optional black polyester sport skort with school logo embroidered on bottom left in white.
- NO skivvies under the sport polo shirt.

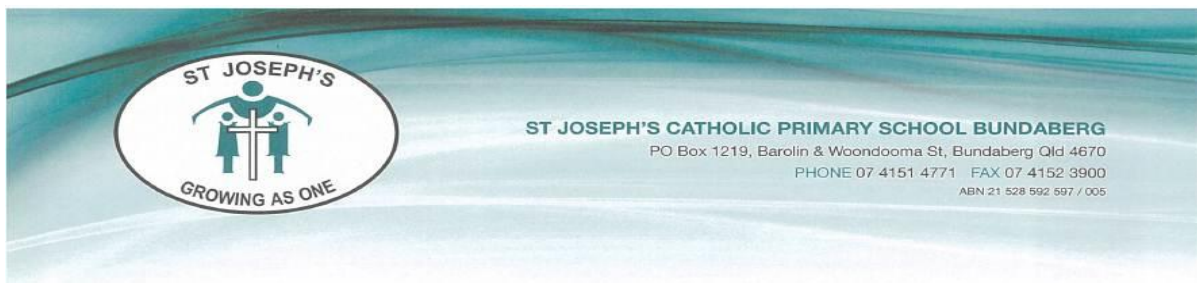




## House Polo Shirts

- St Joseph's House Polo shirts can be worn on inter-house sports carnival days - the swimming carnival and the athletics carnival as well as other designated days as advised by the school.
- House shirts are only available through St Joseph's P & F and can be pre-ordered at specified times throughout the year.





A hat is a compulsory part of the uniform. The school's policy is  
**"No Hat, No Play".**

### *Formal Hat*

- Black broad brim hat with St Joseph's oval school logo badge.
- Compulsory – Year 1-6 - Can be worn with formal and sport uniform.



### *Bucket Hat*

- Black bucket hat with teal trim and embroidered oval school logo on the front.  
Optional - House name embroidered in house colour on the back of the hat brim.
- Optional for Prep to Year 6 - Only to be worn with the sport uniform.



## Jackets



- Unisex black fleecy zip front jacket with St Joseph's embroidered oval school logo.
- Unisex black microfibre zip front jacket with St Joseph's embroidered oval school logo.
- NO skivvies are to be worn under the girls formal dress, boys formal shirt or sport polo shirt.
- Plain black tracksuit pants for winter wear.
- NO tracksuit pants or leggings to be worn under the girls formal dress.
- Shorts/skorts changed into if tracksuit pants removed.
- If jacket and tracksuit pants are worn together and the jacket is removed, then tracksuit pants also to be removed.



## Socks

- White fold-over socks ONLY.

These can be purchased from stores such as Best & Less, Kmart, Big W and Target.



- NO low cut sports socks, crew socks or long socks are to be worn.

## Shoes

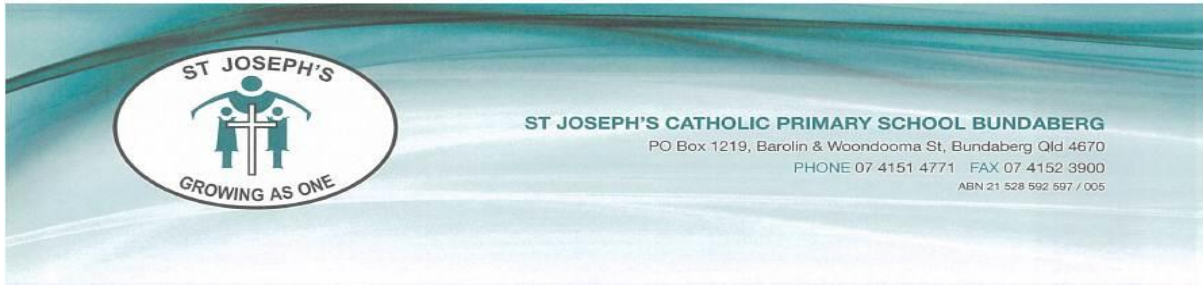
- Plain black leather shoes or joggers, with laces or velcro



- NO canvas shoes or boots.
- NO coloured marks or stripes.
- NO Mary Jane style girls' shoes.

## Prep Uniform

Prep students follow the same guidelines for the uniform but wear the sport uniform every school day with the bucket or formal hat.



## Backpacks

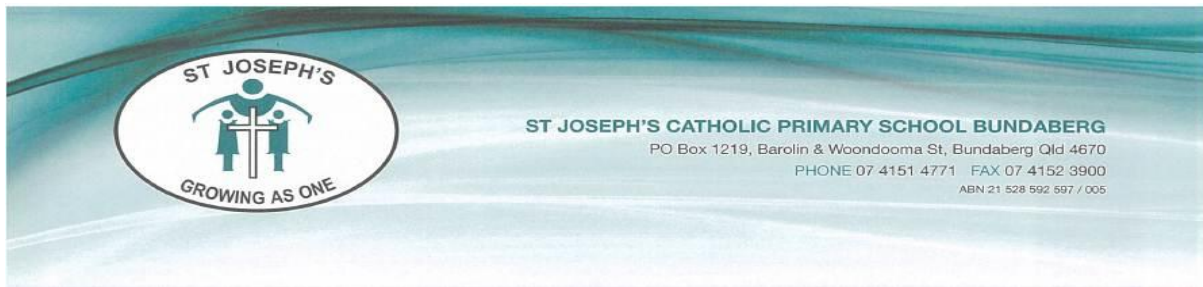
- St Joseph's School backpacks are available from AASTAT Stationery, 13b Electra Street, Bundaberg and are an optional item.
- If you choose to purchase another backpack it is preferred that it be plain black in colour.



## Library Bag

- St Joseph's School library bags are available from AASTAT Stationery, 13b Electra Street, Bundaberg and are an optional item.
- All students must have a library bag to protect books taken between school and home.





## Hairstyles

- Hairstyles for both boys and girls must be neat and appropriate.
- Hair longer than shoulder length, must be tied back with appropriate, school-coloured ribbons, bands or clips only.
- Tracked or shaved styles are not acceptable, nor is dyed or coloured hair.

## Jewellery & Make Up

Minimum jewellery is permitted with the school uniform.

- For girls with pierced ears, only sleepers or studs are to be worn. One pair only and in the lobe of the ear.
- Boys do not wear ear studs.
- Signet rings or holy medallions.
- Analogue / digital watches for students from Years 4 to 6.
- Watches for the younger children are not recommended.

**No 'Smart' devices / watches are to be worn**

- No nail polish or make-up is to be worn to school.
