## **Attitude is Everything**

"Attitude is everything". Attitude isn't everything. And yet... there's something about that saying - attitude is everything - that is useful. It's not that attitude will solve all problems. That's a crazy claim. But what it is... is a way to make the most of a situation, whether positive or negative. And people who have a great attitude tend to do better than those with a less-than-great attitude, regardless of their station or circumstances in life.

There are two useful strategies to supercharge your attitude – reframe and acceptance.

Reframe - the ability to take a bad situation and shift the way we see it, reframe, has been shown to boost mental health. The ability to reframe through noticing positive events, gratitude, mindful awareness, acting in service to others, or finding meaning and purpose have all been shown to improve wellbeing and reduce depression.

Acceptance - recognise the issue or trial, pause to acknowledge it, and then get on with life. "It is what it is" may be a useful reframe, or perhaps just a reset. It's an acknowledgement that things aren't ideal, but they just "are". And once we acknowledge that they just "are", we can then get about finding ways forward again. Force creates resistance. Acceptance allows us the space we need to see things for what they are and reorient ourselves towards what we want.

As our final Project Compassion activity for 2025, students from St Joseph's will participate in a 'Walk For Water Challenge' as a means of raising awareness of the plight of many children their own age around the world who don't have access to clean drinking water in their homes or villages.

Money we raise will help provide access to clean water for some communities.

Did you know . . .

- ... that over 50% of the children currently in hospital around the world are there simply because they don't have access to clean water?
- ... that because they don't have taps in their houses, or even in their villages some have to walk up to 7km each day just to find clean water?
- ... that every day these children are challenged to find clean water?
- ... that these children often can't go to school because they are either too busy collecting water, are too tired from collecting the water or too sick from drinking unclean water?

Today, we're challenging you to help.



Join St Joseph's Catholic Primary School and carry your container of water on a 2 kilometre walk of solidarity with so many other children around the world. Experience a glimpse of what life is like for those not as lucky as we are.

Through your gold coin donation, you'll be helping raise money to help improve access to clean water for children around the world.

## Our Plan

- Participants will carry a 1, 2 or 3 litre containers to the Burnett River (under the old traffic bridge), fill it at a tap or ask an adult to fill it from the river, carry it back to school.

# School Fees Explained

# **How is Education** funded in **Australia?**

The Federal Government "School Resource Standard (SRS)" funding model determines State and Federal Government funding to all schools in Australia.

- For Non-Government schools, the SRS model also identifies each School community's means-tested "Capacity to Contribute (CTC)" through School Fees.
- Unlike many Non-Government schools, Catholic Education -Diocese of Rockhampton (CEDR) schools minimise School fees by delivering education to students within the SRS.

# School funding formula for all schools in Australia > "School Fees"



#### **Base Funding**

Primary Student = \$13,977 Secondary Student = \$17,565 (2025)



Additional funding for six types of students and schools in priority cohorts. Student disadvantage: Indigeneity, Disability, Socio-Educational, Low-English Proficiency. School disadvantage: Size and Location

# **Examples of how CTC impacts School Fees** Where CTC of School community = 90, school fees contribute 10% of the base SRS 18% State Govt Grant Funding 72% Federal Government Grant Funding 10% School Fe Where CTC of School community = 105, school fees contribute 25.5% (primary) or 36.25% (college) of the base SRS Federal Government Primary (59.6%) College (51%)

# How are School fees presented in CEDR schools?

School fees are presented as one All-Inclusive Education fee, that delivers the curriculum offering of the School, rather than a tuition fee PLUS several School-based levies and charges.


